

MUSIC TOGETHER OUTSIDE FAQ – 10-week Spring Session

What should I bring?

- Water proof blanket to sit on and establish your family's space
- POTTY in the car! To keep everyone safe, we cannot offer a bathroom. Please plan ahead and bring a portable potty for your little ones who are learning.
- Props/instruments (homemade or other)
- Hats, mittens, warm gear, extra blanket to drape over yourselves.
- Due to possible allergies and food possibly attracting other children into your space, PLEASE DO NOT bring food into the area. Drinks are fine.

How to Enter IMPORTANT:

- Harwich: Park in the cul-de-sac, leaving the driveway clear, please.
- Orleans: Cars will need to park single file in the driveway (pull as far down as you can to make room for others!). Please DO NOT park in front of neighbor's houses.
- Bourne: Park as many cars as possible in the driveway, single file or on the street in front of the house. DO NOT park in front of neighbor's houses.
- Plymouth: The park is on a corner. You may park on the street (Vernon or Allerton).

What if my child leaves our space?

For now, masks MUST be worn by all adults and children 5 and older. It is important everyone stay on or very near their own space defined by your blanket. If you come within 6 feet of another family, adult masks must be on. If your child is naturally a wanderer, please be prepared to go after them immediately (please do not send grandma or anyone who is not mobile enough to get up quickly with your child to class). We invite you to musically scoop up your child and bring them back to your spot, keep singing and dancing as you do so! We know children like to wander and socialize, but please keep redirecting them back to your area consistently, we do not know how the family next to us feels about contact between kids and should not assume they are ok with it.

What if it rains/snows?

In case of inclement weather, our class will be held on Zoom instead of outside. Please keep an eye on the forecast. You will be notified by text/email/phone and it will be posted on the Facebook page if this occurs. There are absolutely NO refunds or credits due to classes being held online due to unforeseen circumstances.

What if I have to miss a class?

We ask that anyone who knows ahead of time they have to miss, notify Meryl if possible. This way we can offer your seat as a makeup to another family. If there are no outdoor makeups available, you may come to the online Zoom class being offered.

Even though we find ourselves in a very different world right now with more restrictions than we may like, we can still enjoy making music as a group! Meryl has worked hard to find appropriate outdoor spaces for classes (getting permits where needed, adding insurance etc.). So please, let's continue to keep ourselves and everyone around us safe by following these rules. If, after reading all this, you do not think it would be a good fit for your family, please contact the office immediately and we will reschedule you to the online class.
